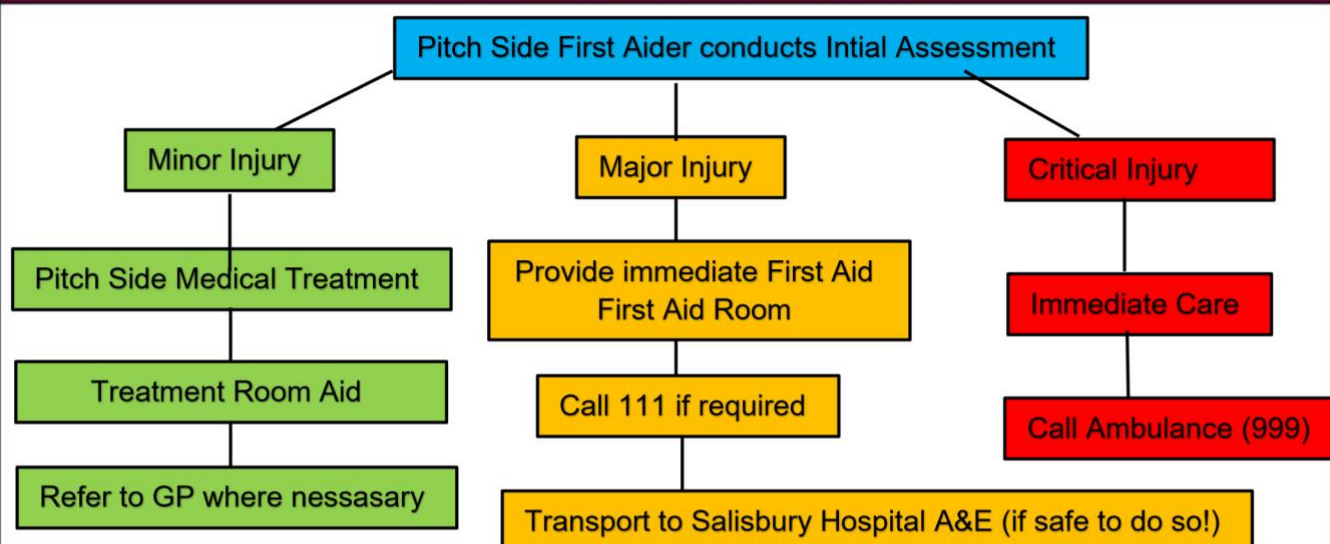

Other Relevant Information

Club Managers **must** report all injuries to the RugbySafe Lead

Club **must** record all injuries to monitor player welfare on Proactive App, insurance purposes, trend anaysis and maintain a proactive injury prevention system.

Ambulance access to pitch and immediately outside pavillion be clear of obstruction.

All are asked to allow the trained medical staff to conduct Initial Triage.

No Medication to be perscribed or issued buy **any** club staff or players.

Only appropriately trained individuals are endorsed to operate debilerator.

If in doubt, call for expert advice (111) or emergency aid (999)
